Code of Conduct for students

1. Every student shall wear clean, neat and formal dress, fitted to our culture and tradition. Casual wear such as shorts and track pants must be avoided.
2. During class hours a student cannot go out of the classroom without the permission of the teacher concerned. The use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited on the college campus. Students who violate this rule will have to face disciplinary action.
3. The college expects students of both gender to foster a healthy and decent relationship both on campus and off campus. The very spirit of co-education lies in facilitating such a relationship. Any behaviour contrary to this spirit is deemed unlawful and punishable.
4. During leisure hours, students are advised to use the library.
5. During leisure hours women students should go to the Girls common room or library. They should not stay in the classrooms.
6. Students shall move from one classroom to another or get out of the classroom in an orderly manner, without making any noise.
7. Students should bring prescribed textbooks to the classes every day.
8. Students should handle the furniture and other properties with care. Damage to the furniture will lead to penalty or suspension from college.
9. Students should stay away from any anti social activities.
10. Students should stay wear their identity cards inside the campus daily.
11. Ragging in any form is a serious offence and it will be dealt with severely.
12. Damage fee will be collected for any damage caused by them knowingly or unknowingly.
