- Discussion on Indian Cyber Law and provision of court proceeding for Cybercrimes.

He gave in depth knowledge of different types of cyber crimes such as access without permission , data theft ,damaging computers , denial of access, access to unauthorised person

, identity theft , cyber staking , cyber terrorism and how to secure oneself and take precautions against such crimes which are at their peak these days .



Further he emphasised to follow safety rules while browsing or during internet transactions .
Precautions such as

- Keeping personal information professional and limited
- Be careful on what you are downloading
- Choosing of strong passwords
- Making online purchases or transactions from secure sites such as shttps
- Carefully posting of the data on social media
- To have complete knowledge of the person while chatting .
- Keeping antivirus up to date .

He discussed some cases related to social media impacts and also provision of court proceeding for Cybercrimes. The seminar was ended with full of Information and vision of being safe and secure in the virtual world.

The Workshop was concluded with presenting vote of thanks to the keynote speakers by Prof . Bhavika Nemade .
